Basic Elements		FL Statutes (FS), Florida Administrative Code (FAC)
Signatures	Eight percent of total votes cast for President at last Presidential election (2012). 683,149 (70% target = 975,927)	FAC 1S-2.0091
Geographical Distribution	Petitions must be signed by a number of electors in each of ½ of the CD's of the state, and the state as a whole, equal to 8%.	FAC 1S-2.0091
Circulation Period	Unlimited. There are no regulations limiting the amount of time a petition can be circulated. Signatures are invalid two (2) years after sign date.	FAC 1S-2.0091
Supreme Court Review	Once the committee obtains signatures from 10% of the voters required from 25% of the congressional districts, the petition is forwarded to the Attorney General, who in turn forwards it to the Supreme court to be reviewed for constitutionality. (10% x 683,149 = 68,315)	Art. XI Sec. 3 State Constitution
Submission Deadline	The Division of Elections must receive all certifications no later than 5:00 p.m. on February 1 of the year in which the election is to be held.	FAC 1S-2.0091
