Basic Elements		Utah Code (UC)
Signatures	The number of signatures needed for a statute is ten percent (10%) of the total votes cast for President in the previous presidential election. That number is 1,017,440 x 10% = 101,744 (70% = 145,349)	UC(20A-7-201(2)(a)(i))
Geographical Distribution	Signatures must be gathered in each of at least 26 of the 29 Utah State Senate Districts equal to 10% of the votes cast for governor in that district.	UC(20A-7-201(2)(a)(ii))
Circulation Period	The Sponsors shall qualify the petition for the regular general election ballot no later than one year after the application is filed.	UC(20a-7-202(4)(a))
Submission Deadline	The petitions must be submitted to the county clerk by April 15, 2014 to appear on the general election ballot and by November 15, 2014 to be submitted to the legislature at the next general session	UT SOS website
